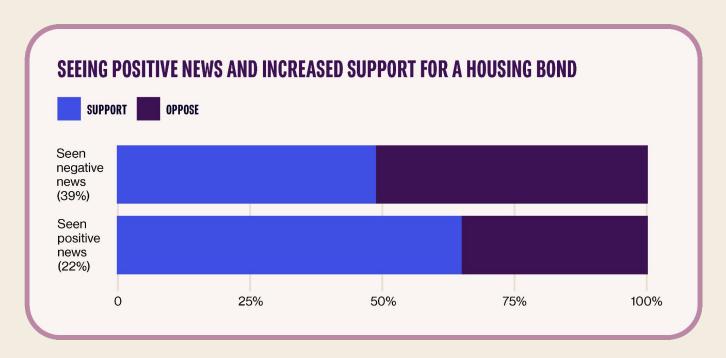

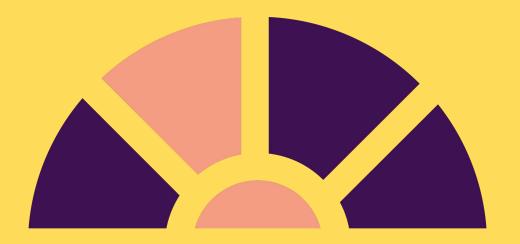

Call everyone in with our shared values

Lead and close with inclusive, values-based language.

Name how all of us are in this together, no matter our race, class, or housing status.





102. Emphasize people over policies

Tell stories about people's aspirations and how their lives are impacted by housing solutions (not the process of passing or implementing new policy).





Uplift the voices of those most impacted by housing issues

Center lived experience and the solutions coming from impacted communities.

Show how the status quo holds all of us back.

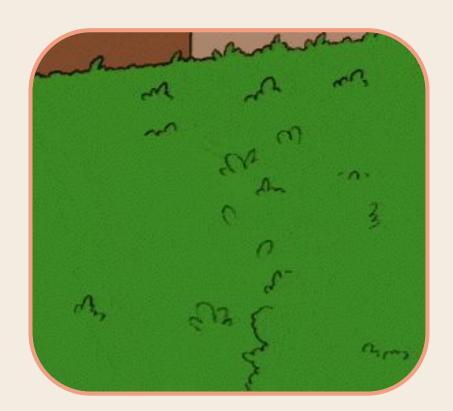




Make solutions visible

Highlight specific ways people's lives have been made better, and specific actions people can take to increase their impact.

Keep the focus on systems and structural change. (And never pit solutions against each other.)





05. Be optimistic and hopeful about the future (cut the doom and gloom)

Be real about the problem, and express outrage when necessary, but avoid crisis language and share reasons for hope.

Ground your stories in the future we make possible by taking action together.





Connect housing justice to other social justice movements, past & present

Remind our audiences that we've won big, hard things by working together before, and call on the pride of the history of Bay Area activism.





O7. Evoke the diversity of the Bay Area and universal feelings of home

Avoid portraying the Bay as a monolith – celebrate the diversity of our communities.

Avoid portraying a singular version of what houses look like — but call on the powerful emotions of home.





Focus on activating allies (instead of opposition voices)

Don't cater to NIMBY and opposition voices, who have a louder presence than they do in numbers.

Make the people we want to be part of our movement the hero of the story.

Listening tour about storytelling needs with organizations and people with lived experience

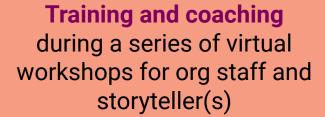
